

## What's New with the Medical Bill Electronic Data Interchange (EDI)

Please forward this announcement to the person in your company who oversees your workers' compensation medical bill data reporting in Washington State.

To date, based on Trading Partner registration of Self-Insured Employers (SIEs), we have:

- 90% registered
- 20% testing

To register as a Trading Partner (sender of medical bill data); go to <a href="Washington L&I Medical Bill EDI">Washington L&I Medical Bill EDI</a> and click on "Trading Partner Registration". To begin testing, see "Implementation Information" and send an email to <a href="WALNIEDI">WALNIEDI</a>.
