Re: Changes to Medical Requirements tables for the WA Electronic Data Interchange (EDI); New Version (V1.8, revised and posted 1/11/2019, effective 12/27/2018) Now Available!

We have updated L&I's Medical Requirements tables. The updated version (V1.8, dated 12/27/2018) has been posted and is available for download at <https://walniedi.info/>. Highlight of changes to the Requirement Tables effective 12/27/2018

Refer to V1.8 Change Log for the specific changes made to support the following change:

- WA L&I is making a change to their medical bill processing. WA L&I will no longer use Employee Date of Birth (DN0052) to match the medical bills to the claim(s) in the WA L&I claim system. This change does not impact the reporting requirements or WA L&I's use of match data at the bill level for Employee Date of Birth on the medical bills because the bills will continue to be matched against previously filed Medical Bill(s).
- There is also a correction made to Date of Injury (DN0031) edits concerning Match Data because Date of Injury was removed as a match data element on the WA L&I Medical Version 1.6 Requirement Tables.
